Athletic teams and sporting events often create and strengthen a bond between a secondary school and the surrounding community. In the case of the North Tonawanda City School District new softball facility, the school district and the community came together in 1999 with TRM to design and construct an area that could be used by students and community members alike.

The city of North Tonawanda as well as NTCSD was much in need of a softball field and this project is an excellent example of the two groups coming together to produce something of mutual benefit. When designing this new facility, TRM took into account the diverse needs of both the community and the school district in terms of functionality for the athletes and comfort for the spectators.

TRM constructed a facility that took advantage of economical yet durable materials in order to maintain the field's functionality and aesthetics despite nearly constant use. Special attention was also paid to ensure proper storm drainage was in place in the field to minimize the effects of the Western New York weather.

The final facility consists of a new field, dugouts, storage, and toilet facilities, and further illustrates TRM's long-term commitment to the community and school district of North Tonawanda.
