



INTERNATIONAL BAG RENOVATION

In 1980, the International Bag Company sought to develop a new plastic bag manufacturing facility. Working with TRM, the chosen solution was the conversion of an existing abandoned brass manufacturing and warehouse facility in Niagara Falls.

In order to convert the facility from its original purpose of brass manufacturing to the production of plastic bags, a complete renovation was required. Working closely with the client, TRM developed, designed, and implemented a new facility better suited to the practice of manufacturing plastic bags.

The renovation included an entirely new floor plan that accommodated the necessary flow of materials and employees throughout the facility and allowed for the most efficient placement of both employees and machinery.

Also included were new break rooms and offices that maximized natural lighting and provided a retreat from the production floor.
